SAVE THE CBO GRANTS PROGRAM



PURPOSE

This toolkit is designed to help nonprofit leaders, staff, board members, and community advocates speak out against the proposed elimination of Miami-Dade County's Community-Based Organization (CBO) Grants Program in the FY 2025–26 budget. Our collective voice is critical to protecting vital services for the most vulnerable. We encourage messaging that is respectful, solutions-oriented, and emphasizes partnership.



WHY THIS MATTERS

While this toolkit focuses on the proposed elimination of the \$16.5 million CBO Grants Program, it's important to understand that the FY 2025–26 Miami-Dade County budget includes an estimated \$40 million in total cuts to nonprofit funding.

In addition to CBO grants, these reductions include:

Arts & Cultural Grants*

Mom & Pop Small Business Grants

Eviction prevention and legal services

Immigrant support and integration programs

Violence prevention and youth programs

*The proposed FY 2025–26 Miami-Dade County budget eliminates **General Fund support** to the County's Arts & Cultural Grants Program, a loss of approximately **\$12.8 million**. This funding previously supported hundreds of nonprofit arts organizations of all sizes, particularly small and mid-sized groups that rely on flexible public funding

These programs are core to the County's safety net and community well-being. The nonprofit sector delivers trusted, cost-effective services that would cost significantly more if handled through government systems alone.

As you advocate for the restoration of the CBO program, consider lending your voice to the broader conversation:

Acknowledge the collective impact of these cuts.

Emphasize that nonprofits are infrastructure.

Include the arts as part of your messaging around nonprofit

Include the arts as part of your messaging around nonprofit funding cuts, and collaborate with groups like Miami-Dade Arts Action Alliance to amplify impact.

Encourage collaboration across sectors to ensure residents do not lose access to critical services.

Together, we can make the case that investing in nonprofits is investing in Miami-Dade's future.

SAMPLE EMAIL TO THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS

Subject: Restore CBO Funding to Protect Our Community

Dear [Commissioner Name] / Mayor Levine Cava,

I am writing as a [nonprofit leader/community member] deeply concerned about the proposed elimination of the Community-Based Organization (CBO) Grants Program in the FY 2025–26 County budget. This program provides more than \$15 million in critical funding to nonprofits that serve seniors, children, immigrants, people experiencing homelessness, and families in crisis.

We appreciate the County's longstanding partnership with the nonprofit sector, and we understand the fiscal challenges ahead. However, we urge you to reconsider this proposal and explore alternative solutions that preserve this vital public-private partnership. As a CBO-funded organization, we [insert short example of impact – e.g., provide 500 meals a week, serve 1,200 seniors annually, offer trauma recovery services to survivors, etc.].

Loss of home care and meals for seniors

These cuts may increase downstream public costs in emergency services, shelters, hospitals, and criminal justice.

Philanthropy alone cannot fill this gap. Continued public investment is critical.

We are eager to collaborate on alternative solutions that protect essential services and uphold Miami-Dade's commitment to community partnerships.
